The International Anti Violence Poster exhibition brings together almost 400 posters from 53 countries around the world. Developed and collated by Colm Dempsey, the exhibition was launched in Dundalk, Ireland, in January 2004.

Powerful and thought provoking, the exhibition contains public education and campaigning posters on a range of issues, including: gender inequality, rape and sexual assault, domestic violence, child protection, child sexual abuse, commercial sexual exploitation, including trafficking, changing attitudes to violence, challenging masculinity.

This exhibition should be of interest and value to those working on issues of: violence and discrimination; crime prevention and safety; child protection; education; youth services; media; advertising; social studies; media studies, as well as individuals who have an interest in, or have been affected by, male violence against women and children.
